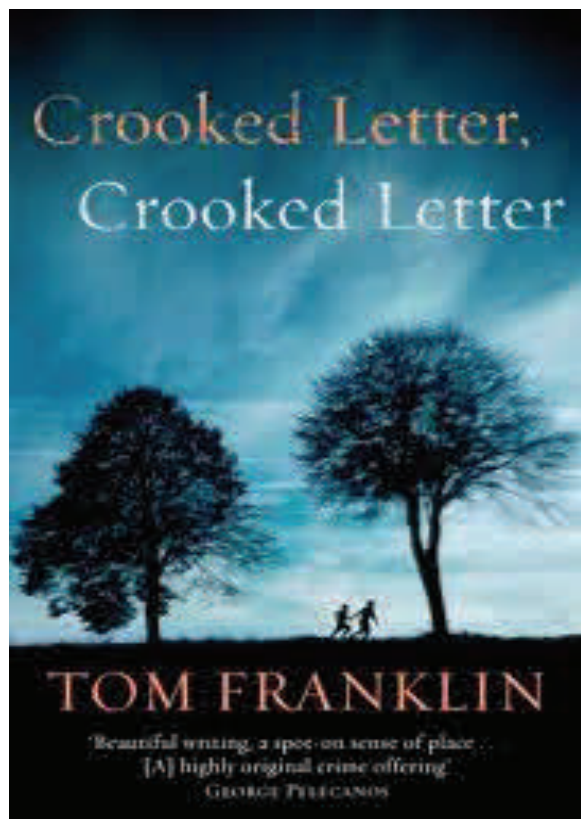


# Adult Book Club selection for *February*
